Andrew Bartlett is currently Director of the Division of Environmental Assessment and Restoration of the Florida DEP. That Division is responsible for implementing the Florida Watershed Restoration Act and the Clean Water Act for the State of Florida including setting water quality standards, monitoring and assessing surface water quality, establishing TMDLs and restoration goals, and developing and implementing Basin Management Action Plans, the blueprint for restoration. Prior to his current position, he was Chief of the Standards, Monitoring, & TMDL Branch at the Environmental Protection Agency, Region 4 office responsible for implementing those programs authorized by the Clean Water Act.

Prior to his work in surface water quality, Andrew spent 10 years implementing programs under the Safe Drinking Water Act. For seven years, Andrew administered the public water supply program in the southeast through the transition of the 1996 Safe Drinking Water Act Amendments. Andrew also administered for three years the ground water monitoring, wellhead protection, and underground injection control programs in the southeast.

Andrew holds an industrial engineering degree from the Georgia Institute of Technology and master of business administration from Georgia State University.
